

German testimony confirms pharaoh lead

The German television broadcasted a program for half-hour last week from the Berlin Museum, specifically from the Department of Egyptology at the Museum. The program was about a discovery of the German scientists specialized in Egyptology. They discovered that the pharaohs were recycling the waste such as papyrus to be used once again, since two thousand BC "four thousand years ago".

The German museum spokeswoman gave an attractive introduction, when she showed the types of masks detected and used in pharaoh coffins. These masks are confined in three types; the first one is the highest price and position, because it is made of pure gold, such as the mask of King Tutankhamun, followed by masks made of wood, while the third type is the less expensive masks made of layers of cardboard similar to gypsum.

Later, the camera has been turned to focus on a part of these masks made of 10 mm thick cardboard covered by outer layer of gypsum drawn upon it a colored picture of the deceased face. Actually, the colored picture consists of carefully adhesive successive layers of papyrus used previously in writing the official or personal documents.

The museum experts engaged in examining some of the masks, which have been received, but the masks were in bad condition because they were exposed to tear and destruction formerly.

Hence, the museum experts tried to separate classes consisting of which the ruined masks by submerging them in chemical solutions to dismantle adhesive substance, linking the layers of papyrus. Unexpectedly, they discover that the used papyruses were just documents, which had been used in writing.

Actually, the papyruses didn't relate to the life of the deceased, or the embalment process either.

The Head of the Restoration Department at the museum showed the stages of separating those writings from each other and the used methods to identify the parts of each one in order to be preserved between two panes of glass.

In the end he explained that those writings have been used in the ancient Egyptians trading, such as the documents of sale, purchase and lease, as well as the documents of due future payment named today "Bill of Exchange". Leases for using field animals were also found, moreover they found documents similar to modern marriage license.

The documents also included a letter from a husband to his wife, ending marital relationship between them politely and respectfully.

He attributed the reason for divorce to the loss of mutual love, then he thanked her for the happy days gathering them, and allowed her to keep the house, all furniture, slaves, animals and birds, moreover he gave her the right to marry another one, pledging to satisfy her financial needs immediately after her request.

Therefore, my dear, you surely have the right to be proud to belong to this country and to be a descendant of this distinguished line of ancestors, who keened on civilization in all its manifestations and solved the problem of waste of resources by recycling, before the world knew about it, this according to authenticated information testimony by scientists of a country of the civilized world.
