School Maintenance

Minister bahha El Din ,and Dr. Shehata and Said Mobarak, director general of Nasr Directorate Dr. Shehata, Said Mubarak, director general of the Department, Nasr City, the advanced technical school for Maintenance Technology which was established to prepare for technical maintenance and repair, is going to use the latest Electronic and Mechanical devices, the only of its kind in this discipline at the level of the Republic.

The Minister said that the school is built on 44 thousand square meters, of which 9 thousand square meters are buildings and 35000 square meters, playgrounds and green surfaces, with 30 classrooms and 750 students theater can play in addition to various games and number of laboratories specializing in electronic engineering and , electronic and electrical engineering, measurements and control systems electronics power and communications and an audio-visual lab and a workshop . Electronics, telecommunications, computer networks and workshop equipment and protective mechanics and welding and metal forming devices.

Dr. Bahaa Eddin, went on to say, that the establishment of the school is part of an integrated series in order to increase environmental awareness and preservation of the aesthetic forms of school buildings and furniture, a national wealth that must be maintained.

The students were assigned to repair and maintain school furniture around Cairo as well as modern equipment and we look forward to their success .

The presence of a maintenance unit in all schools is a necessity, for the repair and maintenance of public facilities within the school, even graduated students should be interested in respecting the environment.
