I have the pleasure to extend my congratulations to you on the occasion of the end of the school year. Also, I have the honor to submit a report on the final results of **Dr. Nader Riad Integrated School**-El-Ayyat Education Department, and the school activities during the school year 2004/2005, together with the future plans of the school year 2005/2006, as follows:

First: The school has received the highest success rate of 99% in the Preparatory Certificate for the eighth year successively on the level of El-Ayyat Education Department which includes 40 schools. This year, 206 students sat for the examinations. Twenty of them received 90% with with a grade of **Excellent**, 101 students received between 80% and 90% with a grade of **Very good** 79 received between 65% and 80% with a with a grade of **Good**, and 3 students received a grade of Satisfactory

On the other hand, Dr. Nader Riad Integrated Preparatory School received **the best, clean and developed school** from the recognition of the Education Directorate, Giza.

Second: To encourage students to develop their abilities as well as their talents in the different fields, the school is concerned with promoting the different school activities through:

1- Computer activities:

The school achieved a success rate of 100% in the final exam 2004/2005 of the experimental computer curriculum. About 453 students in preparatory two and three, who are registered in the school, sat for the theoretical and practical examinations. The general average of the grades was 75%. This was through the computer lab in the school which was previously supplied with 10 computers.

2- Sports activity:

Believing in the saying “**sound minds are in sound bodies**”, the school devotes care to sports activities by organizing different sports competitions among the student teams. At the end of the year, a sports event was held and attended by the leaders of El-Ayyat Education Department and Giza Sports Inspectors.

3- Art activities:

The school devotes great care to developing the students' talents by dividing them into groups for plastic and pictorial arts under the supervision of arts teachers in the school. Art competitions with other schools are arranged , along with exhibitions in the school so as to display students' works. They are aided by graduates of the faculty of Fine Arts who work in Bavaria company.

4- Musical activities:

The school is concerned with developing the students' talents in music by forming groups to be trained to play musical instruments and to sing national songs under the supervision of music teachers. Concerts and competitions are held to present the special talents in the school.

5- Library activities:

In an extension of the “Festival of Reading for All” sponsored by Mrs. Suzanne Mubarak, the school was supplied with different modern books and educational video tapes in order to develop the students' culture and broaden their minds.

6. Summer activities:

The school holds a summer club for the students so as to make the best use of their leisure time, where they practice different sports and art activities and deal with computer programs in the school lab.

A celebration honoring the top students will be held at the amusement park, Dream Park. It will be attended by parents, the Manger of the Education Department in El-Ayyat the school headmaster, the teachers and their families within the framework of the social climate offered by the company to the school.

Third: The financial budget to support the school activity during the school year 2004/2005

The budget for this school year 2004/2005 amounted to L.E. 212,048.00 to cover the different educational activities in the school and was allocated as follows:

Fourth: Estimated budget for next school year 2005/2006:

The estimated budget for next school year amounts to L.E. 224,300.00 It is in excess of last year by L.E. 12252,00 in order to support the school activities and it is allocated as follows:
