His Royal Highness Prince Talal Bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud was born in 1935 in Taif, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. He was raised with a real love for philanthropy and a firm belief in the importance of solidarity with the poor and needy.

His core philosophy in humanitarian work is based on a strong conviction that protecting the dignity of disadvantaged citizens around the world can only be achieved by investing in people.

Prince Talal was one of the first to provide scholarships to a large number of Saudi youth, enabling them to study in international universities. He also established the first school for women in Riyadh in the early '80s, recognizing that women play a key role in the development of their societies. Prince Talal has also undertaken many initiatives in the field of development. One of the best known is the establishment of the Arab Golf Programme for United Nations Development Organization to support efforts that promote sustainable human development.
